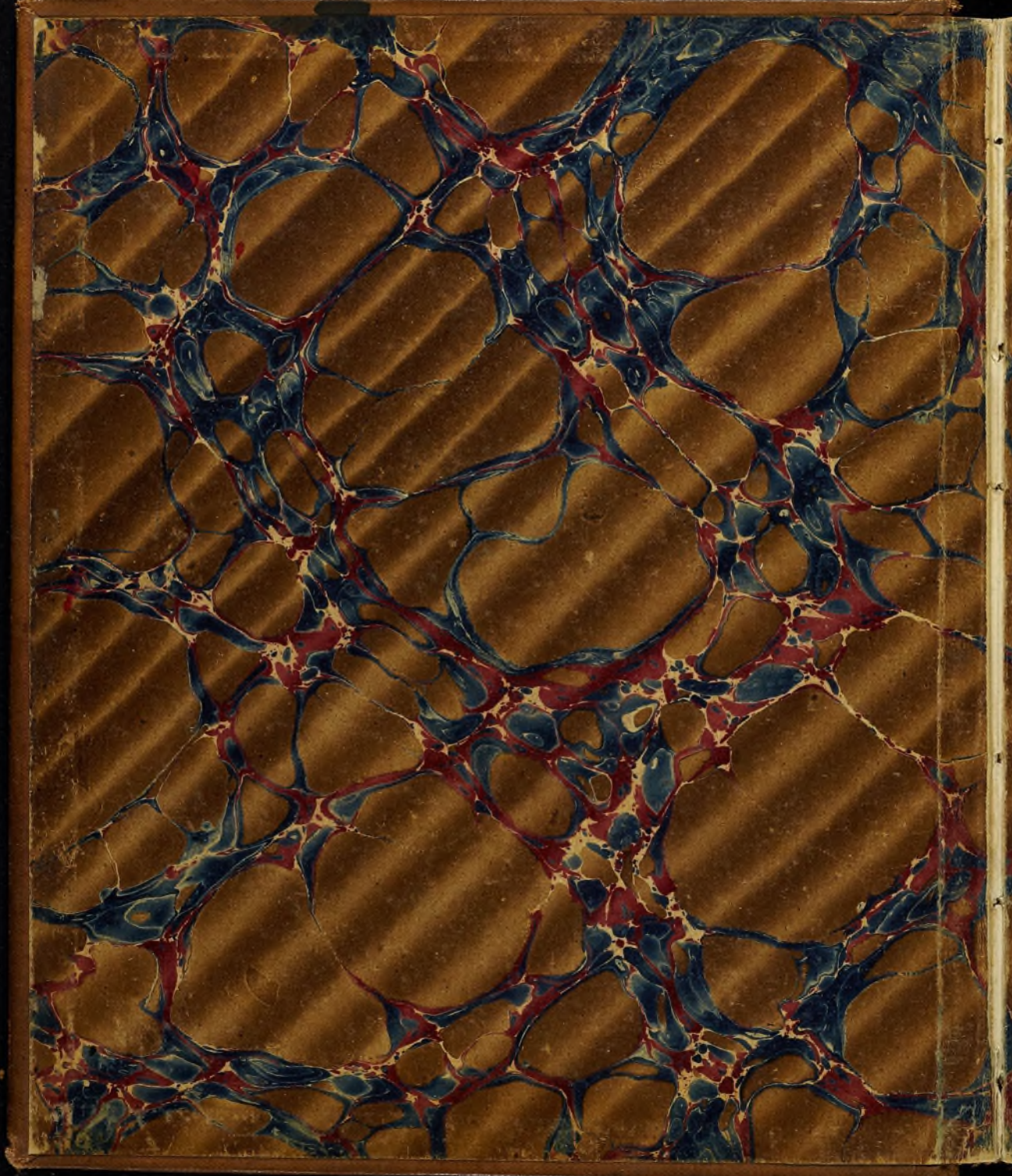

SUGGESTIONS BY THE FINANCE COMMITTEE FOR THE CLUB BOOK & ACCOUNTS

1. That the work at present done by the Secretaries be divided between the Secretary and the Treasurer.
2. All subscriptions and other monies to be paid to the Hon. Treasurer only, who alone shall be responsible for same, and for the writing up and keeping of all the financial books of the Club.
3. The Secretary shall be responsible for all general correspondence, writing up of Minutes, election of Members etc., but shall have nothing to do with the Collection or payment of any monies.
4. All monies received to be banked at least once a week.
5. A Cheque to be drawn for say £10, or a sufficient sum to provide the Hon. Treasurer with Petty Cash between Committee meetings.
6. The Club Committee to meet regularly once a month on a fixed day (say the first ~~Wednesday~~ <sup>Thursday</sup> in each month at 8.30 p.m.)
7. The Cash Book and Petty Cash Book to be kept written up to date and produced at every Committee meeting together with the Bank Pass Book, which shall be laid upon the table for inspection. The Hon. Treasurer shall report the Bank Balance and shall also state what accounts, if any, he may recommend for payment which accounts shall be produced and if passed by the Committee shall be entered on the Minutes as such, and cheques drawn for same. A Cheque shall also be drawn for the Petty Cash disbursements made since the previous meeting so as to bring the balance in hand up to the regulation figure of say £10.
8. No cheque to be drawn upon the Club account for any payments which have not been so passed by the Committee.
9. No credit to be given for Stock sold.
10. A Stock Book to be kept shewing the quantities of Stock purchased and sold, a separate account being opened for each class of goods, e.g. sweaters, socks, vests, etc., showing on the one side the quantities purchased, and on the other the number sold. This should prevent the present leakage.

BAR ACCOUNTS.

1. The work of the Hon. Stewards to be divided, one to be directly responsible to the Committee for all money received and for the keeping of the financial books.

2. All monies to be banked at least once a week. *\* Stewards to be settled every week, after they have come before Committee.*

The Hon. 6. No cheques to be drawn upon the Bar Account, *except the Stewards weekly cheques* for any payments which have not been so passed by the Club Committee.

7. No credit to be given to any member.

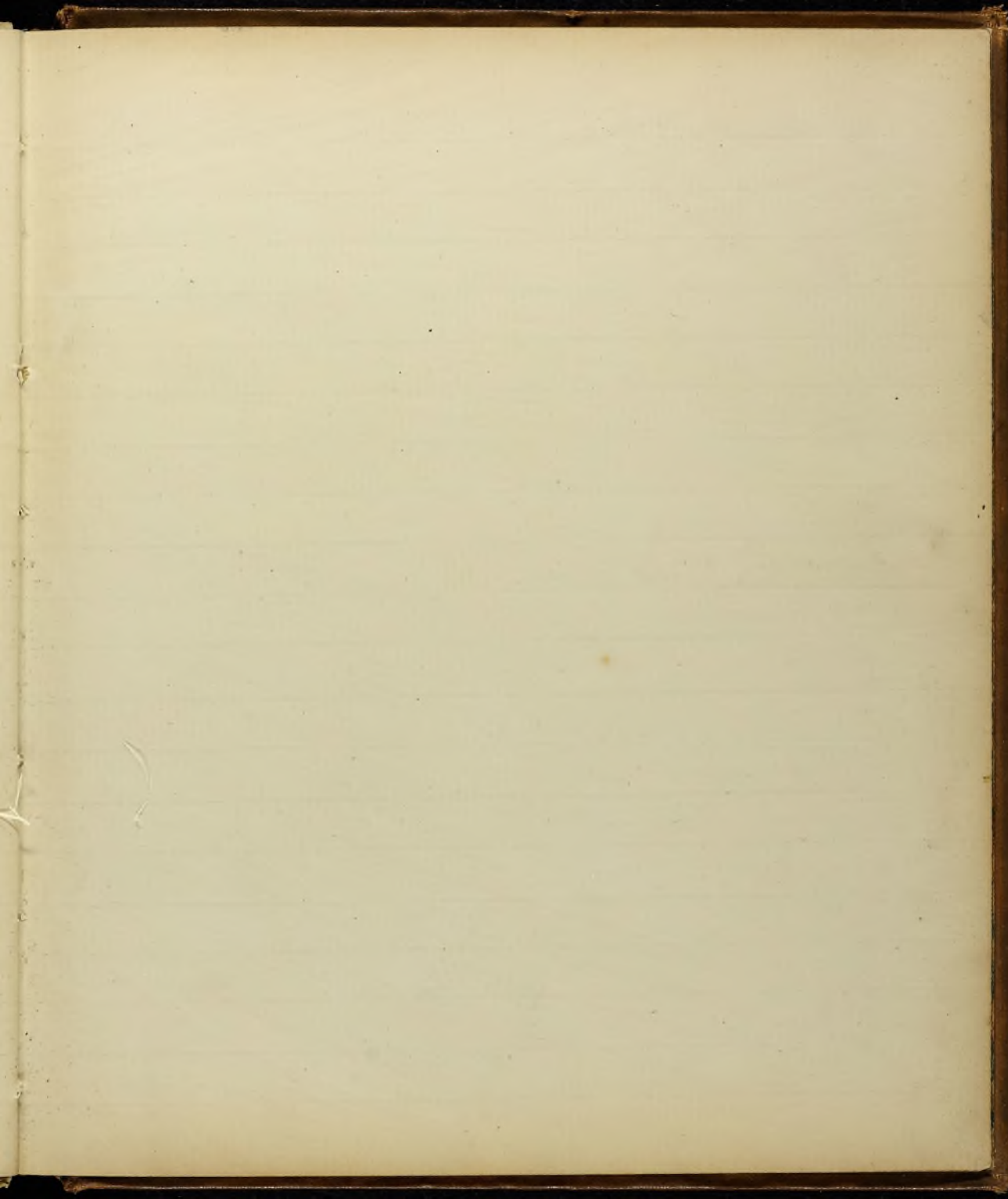
